Note 1: There are some 11 words (at the end of this list) for which the place of publication has not been recorded by me.

Note 2: The fourth column shows the place of publication. Journals are noted by their usual abbreviation. Book = a monograph, c = a commentary, dict = a lexicon, Fs = a Festschrift.

Note 3: The fifth column shows the School to which the author belongs, according to my definition of philological Schools in my paper 'Philology and Power', in *On the Way to the Postmodern: Old Testament Essays 1967-1998, Volume 2* (JSOTSup, 292; Sheffield: Sheffield Academic Press, 1998), pp. 613-30 ([=www.shef.ac.uk/bibs/DJACcurrres/Postmodern2/Philology.html](http://www.shef.ac.uk/bibs/DJACcurrres/Postmodern2/Philology.html))
O = Oxbridge, J = Jewish, R = Rome, A = American, G = German, S = Swiss.

Note 4: The data in square brackets show in which corpora the word occurs (B = Bible, Si = Ben Sira, Q = Qumran, I = Inscriptions), and the total number of occurrences (including occurrences in emendations).

Note 5: The 'author' of a proposal for a New Word is the person I have been able to identify as the first proposer of the word. In a number of cases, there may well have been an earlier author responsible for the suggestion, who is unknown to me.
